- Diagnostic Services: Testing to detect, diagnose, and treat diseases, injuries, or other physical conditions.
- Health Informatics: Management of patient information, financial information, and computer applications related to healthcare.
- Support Services: Ensures other health care professionals can accomplish their duties.
- Therapeutic Services: Care, treatment, or counseling to improve the patient's status over time.
